WAMAVA's Purpose

Camp WAMAVA's primary mission is spiritual. It exists to provide camping in a Christian environment and to glorify God. Emphasis is also placed on the physical and emotional growth of the young people who attend the camp. A look at an average day's activities serves to illustrate the balance that is sought to put the camping experience in the proper perspective. Spiritual aspects of Camp WAMAVA are emphasized daily through Bible classes and devotionals. Physical and emotional growth receives proper emphasis during periods of organized recreation and free time. Recreational activities include large and small group games, supervised swimming, hiking and crafts. And to complete their physical growth needs, campers enjoy three meals during the day and have snacks at "canteen" time.

The encampment director and his staff are under the direction of the Camp WAMAVA Board of Directors. All are Christians committed to offering every child the broadest possible program instilling spiritual, physical and emotional growth. Camp fees defray only a part of the expense of each camper attending the summer sessions. The remainder of the money needed to operate the camp is provided by donations from generous Christians. These people who love the children of the Washington metropolitan area believe that the camp provides a valuable physical and spiritual opportunity for these young people.

Who May Attend Camp WAMAVA

Any boy or girl without regard to their race, color, national origin, religion, handicap or sex, who will be in grades 3 through 12 in the Fall and who is willing to abide by the camp rules may attend Camp WAMAVA. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, as they are received by the camp registrar. Campers going into grades 4 through 9 may stay for a maximum of two (2) weeks.

Camper Fees and Registration Information

The fee is \$225 per week per child. The camper fee must be paid in full upon arrival at camp for registration. Incremental payments are accepted between initial deposit and arrival at camp. Applications should be received at least two weeks before the beginning of the session(s) for which the camper is planning to attend.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

- 1) Check or money order is accepted when you send in your signed registration form to the address below. A minimum of \$75 deposit is required with application. Money order or cash is accepted to pay the balance upon arrival to camp.
- 2) If you choose to pay by credit card, go to www.wamava.com and select "online payment". The fee is \$225. If you pay online, you will be charged the full amount per week! Payment by major credit card is accepted through online payment ONLY.

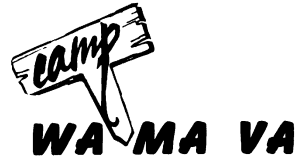
With either of the options above, campers will receive a registration number at the time their signed application is received and processed by the registrar. Your registration number will be sent to you in an e-mail confirmation. Campers will be admitted in the order of their registration number. "Walk-ins" will be accepted after 4:00 p.m., if space allows. Cabin assignments are made at check-in on the first day you arrive.

CHECK-IN is between 2:00-4:00 p.m. on the SUNDAY your first day of camp. CHECK-OUT is from 9:00-11:00 a.m. on SATURDAY, your last day at camp.
